It is a great honour for us to welcome Gerhard Marcel Martin to Utbildningscentrum Lidingö on December 2, 2010 - December 4, 2010. G.M Martin has been a professor of applied theology at Philipps-University in Marburg, Germany since 1982.

Professor Martin focuses on multidimensional hermeneutics in connection with religious texts. In Germany and Europe he has been one of the most important people for the development of Bibliodrama since the 70's. Prof. Martin does research around spirituality and promotes a dialogue between theology and deep psychology and between theology and esthetics.

Prof. Martin has published more than 10 books and is also included in a number of anthologies. He has reviewed books and written many forewords and afterwords to books on Bibliodrama in Germany.

Prof. Martin has been published in the journal *TEXTRAUM* for 20 years; a journal published by the German Bibliodrama Society. Unfortunately there are no books translated into Swedish available. *Sachbuch Bibliodrama - Praxis und Theorie*, Stuttgart 1995, 2001 is considered a description of Bibliodrama and its development. The book is translated into Hungarian in 2003 and into Finnish in 2008.
